## WPS 50th ANNIVERSARY CLINICAL MEETING 2023

## LAKE VYRNWY HOTEL, POWYS, MID WALES THURSDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2023 – FRIDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2023

Dr David Tuthill, President of the Welsh Paediatric Society and Dr Johann te Water Naude, Honorary Secretary of the Welsh Paediatric Society are pleased to be hosting the Welsh Paediatric Society 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Clinical Meeting 2023 at the Lake Vyrnwy Hotel in Powys, Mid Wales.

Dr David Tuthill and Dr Johann te Water Naude would like to invite their paediatric colleagues from across Wales and neighbouring deaneries to attend the 2-day clinical meeting from Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June which will celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Welsh Paediatric Society. It will include a dinner followed by live entertainment.

50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Clinical Meeting 2023: The clinical meeting will take place at the Lake Vyrnwy Hotel in Powys, Mid Wales from Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023

Welsh Paediatric Society Informal Meal: The Welsh Paediatric Society will host an informal meal at the Lake Vyrnwy Hotel in Powys, Mid Wales on Wednesday 14th June. Dependant on weather we hope to be able to have a barbecue outdoors on the grounds.

**Welsh Paediatric Society Dinner:** The Welsh Paediatric Society dinner will be held at **Lake Vyrnwy Hotel** on the evening of <u>Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June</u>. A drinks reception will take place at 7.30pm, with a 3-course dinner from 8.00pm followed by live entertainment. Dinner and entertainment are included in the registration fee, and a nominal charge of £30.00 will be applied to medical students and to guests (honorary members and non-members) who are only attending the dinner.

**Registration Fees:** Fees include morning refreshments, lunch, mid-afternoon refreshments and a 3-course dinner followed by entertainment on **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June**. WPS members will receive **a reduced rate** if booked as an Early Bird registration. Delegate rates are as follows:

There is no charge for the conference for honorary members, **but they will still need to register for the meeting for administrative purposes.** The cost for honorary and retired members attending the dinner only will be £35.00 per person. The cost for medical students attending the dinner will be an additional £10.00. This includes a 3-course meal, wine and entertainment. Please note: The fee for those only able to attend the clinical meeting remains unchanged with no further discount for not attending the Welsh Paediatric Society Dinner.

**Early Bird Discount:** WPS Members, please note that Early Bird Registrations must be received and paid for no later than **Friday 19**<sup>th</sup> **May** by registering on the Welsh Paediatric website. If payments are <u>not</u> received by this date the full registration fees will be applied.

Attendance without prior registration: Members and non-members arriving for the meeting without prior registration will be charged the full £140.00. Please note registration or payment is not available on the day.

**Venue:** The Lake Vyrnwy Hotel is located on the hills of the Berwyn Mountains, overlooking the beautiful Lake Efyrnwy. Built in 1890, this 4-star Victorian Country House Hotel is positioned on the edge of Snowdonia National Park within a 24,000-acre nature reserve, it offers a unique setting and is one of the most famous picturesque backdrops in Mid Wales.

The hotel has 52 individually decorated bedrooms, 35 of those having lake views and some with special features such as balconies and four posters. Rooms all have a flat screen TV and free Wi-Fi is available in public areas.

Lake Vyrnwy Hotel is within an hour's drive of Shrewsbury and Wrexham. Free on-site parking is available, and the Welsh Border is a 30-minute drive away.

Accommodation Rates: Accommodation will be available at the resort with a special rate for single and double occupancy.
